

Kings Park Soccer Club Fund Raising Committee

The Fund Raising Committee of The Kings Park Soccer Club ("the Club" or "Club") shall deal with all areas of fund raising that may arise for Club sponsored events.

The Fund Raising Committee

The Fund Raising Committee shall have the obligation to work with the Club Treasurer and the Club's Budget & Finance Committee to establish realistic Fund Raising goals for the Club on an annual basis. Included in this obligation will be to review past fund raising events and activities as well as to review and recommend new events and activities to help meet the financial needs of the Club as established by the Club Treasurer and the Club's Budget & Finance Committee. All monies raised by the Fund Raising Committee will go to the Treasurer. The Fund Raising Committee will submit a budget request to Club Treasurer and the Club's Budget & Finance Committee prior to September 1st of each year to cover the estimated expenses related to fund events and activities.

It will be a reasonable goal of Fund Raising Committee to exceed the proceeds of the same or similar past fund raising events and activities by at least 5% per annum.

1. *Composition* - There will be no less than three (3) and no more than five (5) members, including a Committee Chair on the Fund Raising Committee ("Chair"). Fund Raising Committee members shall be selected by the Club President, with the approval of the Board of Directors for a one-year term. The Club President shall appoint the Chair of the Fund Raising Committee.

2. *Voting* - Voting of this Committee shall be one (1) vote for each member of the Committee including the Chair.

3. *Participants at a Fund Raising Committee Meeting* - The Fund Raising Committee reserves the right to determine the participants and number of participants that may attend a Fund Raising Committee meeting.

4. *Fund Raising Committee Meetings* - The Fund Raising Committee will hold no less than 2 meetings annually - 1 in August and 1 in January - and will convene additional Meetings at the discretion of the Chair.

The August meeting will be held for the purpose of organizing the fund raising events and activities for the Fall Season. The January meeting will be held for the purpose of organizing the fund raising events and activities for the Spring Season.

5. *Records of the Fund Raising Committee* - The Fund Raising Committee will keep notes and minutes of their meetings, which will be forwarded onto the Club's Board of Directors.

6. *Matters Not Provided* - Any matters not provided for in these rules shall be determined by the Board of Directors of the Club and decisions so made shall be final and binding.
