The KPSC recognizes that the adults involved with this club are role models for our youth and as such advocates a tobacco, alcohol and drug free experience. We rely on our board members, coaches, parents, visitors, aides, referees and players to reinforce the importance of being tobacco-free, alcohol-free and drug-free.

In the best interest of our children, the KPSC recommends:

That all practices, games, and competitions stay tobacco, alcohol and drug free on the fields and grounds.

That KPSC sponsored events, including but not limited to, Soccer Day, Registration, Clinics, Parades, Pictures, Camps, and outings remain tobacco, alcohol and drug free.

That carpools to and from KPSC related events remain tobacco, alcohol and drug free.

Please understand that KPSC recognizes that adults make their own decisions. Our only intention is to present to our children a lifestyle of healthy choices and to help them recognize the dangers related to tobacco, alcohol and drugs.
